



## IDEA BOXES WHERE WILL THEY BE NEXT?



**Mad Mattr:** Make LEGO®-like bricks or use the other molding tools provided to make a castle or whatever your creative mind imagines.

**Origami:** Fold a Peace Crane: Patrons may refer to printed directions on how to fold a peace crane and add it to a growing string of cranes to travel along in the system, or take your crane home. Patrons may draw inspiration from Fold Me a Poem to write poetry based on their origami creations.

**Zip**, **Zap**, **Zing**: Make a simple circuit, an LED greeting card, a paper lantern, and more.

Sew, Stitch, Wrap, Weave: Weave on burlap with feathers or yarn. Make a mini quilt with fabric squares and backing fabric. Make a coaster on a mini potholder loom. Create a cute owl with burlap and buttons. Bead On: Make a button necklace or bracelet, kid necklaces and bracelets, adult bracelets, toe rings, bookmarks, and try the lacing activities for toddlers!

Sound of Science: Make a straw oboe and a craft stick harmonica.

Duct Tape Creations: Make a duct tape bookmark, library card wallet, or pencil pouch.

Mini gardens: Create a small Zen garden out of sand and colored glass stones.

The Small Shall be Strong, A History of Lake Tahoe's Washoe Indians

Matthew Makley, PhD, Professor of History, Metropolitan State University of Denver

This lecture will give a brief, historical overview of the Washoe (Wašhiw) people whose ancestors began occupying the Tahoe region up to 10,000 years ago. The lecture highlights the fact that Washoe history is an important, and often overlooked, part of the region's history. It is also an important part of the national historical narrative. Topics covered will include the legal battle over Cave Rock and the Washoe's unique use of the General Allotment Act in 1887.




Wednesday, January 15, 5:30 pm Harold's Club: World's Largest Casino

Neal Cobb, Reno Historian

Harold's Club emerged from a hole-in-the-wall operation at 236 North Virginia Street to become the largest casino in the world and helped to put Reno on the map. Neal Cobb is a Reno native born at Washoe Medical Center in 1939 when the city's population was about 32,000. Neal fell heir to fourteen large boxes of old Reno and northern Nevada photos and printable film after his parents died in 1985-86 and subsequently authored two books, *Reno Now and Then*, books I and II. He has worked closely representing the Nevada Historical Society, having presented over 500 programs in Reno, Sparks and northern Nevada since 1988.

The Westside Slugger: Joe Neal's Lifelong Fight for Social Justice Downtown Reno

John L. Smith. Author and Journalist

The Westside Slugger is the powerful story of civil rights in Las Vegas and Nevada through the eyes and experience of Joe Neal, a history-making state lawmaker in Nevada. Neal rose from humble beginnings in Mound, Louisiana during the Great Depression to become the first African American to serve in the Nevada State Senate. John L. Smith is a longtime journalist and the author of more than a dozen books on some of the most significant characters in Las Vegas history. In three decades as a daily columnist with the Las Vegas Review-Journal, he garnered many state and national awards for his work.

Samantha Szesciorka, Assistant Curator, Wilbur D. May Center Wilbur May was the third son of David May, founder of The May Department Stores Company. Wilbur was a rancher, pilot, artist, philanthropist, and world traveler who lived in Reno from 1936 until his death on January 20, 1982. The museum's collection derives from over 40 trips Wilbur made around the world, and includes T'ang Dynasty pottery, African masks, statues and artwork, Inuit scrimshaws, Egyptian scarab figures, Greek icons, wildlife dioramas and a shrunken head from South America. Also featured is a re-creation of the living room, bedroom, tack room, and big game trophy room from Wilbur's 2,600-acre (1,100 ha) Double Diamond Ranch in South Reno.
