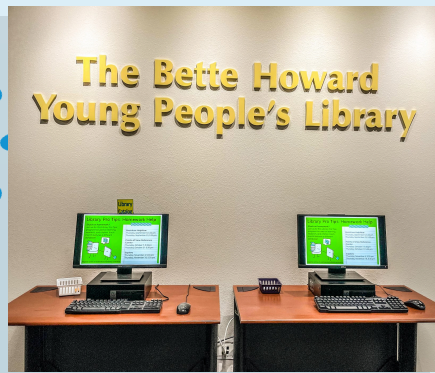

The **Northwest Reno Library** first opened its doors on June 12, 1999. The beloved branch was the result of an innovative public-private partnership, which saw a former manufacturing plant converted into a modern and attractive addition to the Washoe County Library System.

After more than two decades of dedicated service, we eagerly embraced the opportunity for renovation. Funding for the project was provided by Washoe County in partnership with the Tacchino Trust, as part of the long-standing effort to ensure that a first-class library system is available to all.

The renovation has focused on many improvements—all with community enjoyment and convenience in mind. Heavily trafficked flooring has been replaced with new carpeting and durable vinyl planking. Public meeting rooms, gallery space, and reading areas now enjoy a renewed ambiance and benefit from improved safety. New furniture, ranging from comfortable reading chairs to collaborative study tables, has been installed. These improvements have positioned the branch to better meet the community's needs.



The Tree House, a highlight of the Northwest Reno Young People's Library, has been revitalized with fresh, fun paint and new flooring.

Fresh paint has added to the building's vibrancy, most noticeably in the Young People's Library. A staggering \$100,000 from the Tacchino Trust was dedicated to purchasing new children's materials. Families will find a lively, welcoming environment well-stocked with favorite titles. Finally, an improved floor plan enhances ease of access to the collection and creates a more dynamic space.

With so much to show you and so much to offer, the staff at the Northwest Reno branch are excited to welcome the community back to the newly improved and remodeled branch.

Computer use and collaborative study throughout the library will be more comfortable with new ergonomic chairs. New lounge seating and laptop tables, easy access for charging your personal devices, and study tables will provide a pleasant atmosphere for research and leisure reading while in the library. It's all part of our commitment to being a hub for living and learning in Sparks.

The workshop features local experts on topics including planning your will and/or trust, power of attorney, duties of executors and successor trustees, protecting digital assets, long-term care considerations, and more.

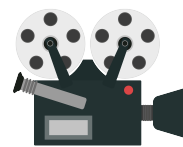

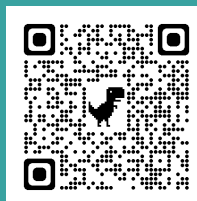

How Did You Survive? is a Las Vegas-based, thought-provoking exhibition of stories of 50 Holocaust survivors primarily from Nevada.
