## 2006-07 Library Highlights:

A community coalition presented **Northern Nevada Reads: A Project of the Big Read**. More than 42 programs and events surrounding Ray Bradbury's *Fahrenheit 451* took place from August-October 2007.

The design phase for the **Downtown Reno Library remodel** was completed.

**Downloadable audio books** can be checked out on the library website. More than 571 titles are currently available.

The Library System has implemented a **Balanced Scorecard** strategic planning process. The team revised the library system's mission and vision statements, and developed priority and long-term objectives and initiatives that align with the County's strategic priorities.

The **Summer Reading Program** broke all records with 7,867 registered participants (up 16%) reading a total of 2,974,280 minutes (a 36% increase over the previous year).

Incline Village Library received an award in the second annual Reno Magazine/AIA Northern Nevada Architecture Design Awards competition.

A total of **17,161 citizens voted early** at nine libraries in the 2006 election.

WCLS librarians visited **64 elementary schools** and delivered library information to nearly **5,700 third graders**.

More than **1,900 library materials** were delivered to **community homeless shelters** and child welfare agencies.

Online GED services are now available.

A 1,300 volume library was established at the Jan Evans Juvenile Justice Center.



## Friends of Washoe County Library:

The Friends continues its strong support of the Library system with over 1,000 members. The organization has raised more than \$2.2 million since 1991. Key projects included serving as fiscal agent for the Big Read project and opening the year-round Book Warehouse operation. The Friends' Second Century Endowment Fund topped \$250,000 in assets that can make a long-term commitment to benefit the library.
